2.2. The Slalom competition will be held as a double race on May 30 and 31, 2026, under the name "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I and II," and it will count towards:

- CEZ Championship - "Prix Zrenjanina 2026 I" – only Maj 30, 2026
- National Championship of Serbia - "Prix Zrenjanina 2026 I and II" – both days
- Open Championship of Serbia - "Prix Zrenjanina 2026 I and II" – both days
- SAKSS Championship - "Prix Zrenjanina 2026 I and II" – both days
- Open Championship of Vojvodina - "Prix Zrenjanina 2026 I and II" – both days

The competition is held on the track within the industrial zone "Southeast Ečka" at the southern entrance to Zrenjanin.

- On Saturday 30 and Sunday May 31, 2026. from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the "Zrenjanin" track (in the zone between the start and pre-start).

2.8. The competition notice boards will be located in the service park on May 30 and 31, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Results will also be announced on the viber group "Zrenjani 26 slalom".

ARTICLE 3. TRACK, TIME MEASUREMENT, AND RESULTS

- 3.1.** The double auto slalom race is held on the track "Zrenjanin 2" on the road Lukano selo - Zrenjanin (Mužlja).
- 3.2.** The Slalom track "Zrenjanin 2" is paved and is 1,858 meters long. The track includes the following elements:
- **CONES IN A SERIES:** 8 cones in a series with a distance of 16 m, entrance on the right 3 pieces
 - **GATES:** with 4 gates 3 m wide with a distance of 15 m each, entrance on the right..... 3 pieces
 - **GATES:** with 4 double gates width 3 x length 4 m with a distance of 15 m each, entrance on the right 2 pieces
 - **CHICANES:** with 4 transverse obstacles with a distance of 15 m each, entrance on the right..... 3 pieces
- 3.3.** The surface in the service park area is asphalt.
- 3.4.** The competition consists of 2 training runs, and 3 racing runs.
- 3.5.** Time measurement is done using an electronic stopwatch with a photo cell at the start and finish.
- 3.6.** All results can be followed live on the website [<http://timing.racingtribe.com>]
- 3.7.** The number of competitors is limited to 80.

ARTICLE 4. VEHICLES

- 4.1.** All vehicles participating in the "Prix Zrenjanina 2026 I" competition for the **FIA CEZ Slalom Championship** will be divided as follows:
- **Division 1:** Group N (including R1) and Group A (including R2 and R3, WRC & KITC), S2000, SP (all together)
 - **Division 2:** Group E1*, E2-SH*, GT
 - **Division 3:** Group Standard Production Cars** and Group Modified Production Cars*** (all together)
- * = according to national regulations (each car must have a confirmation from the national ASN that the car complies with national regulations).
- ** = each car must comply with the FIA-CEZ technical regulations for production cars
- *** = each car must comply with the FIA-CEZ technical regulations for modified production cars
- 4.2.** All vehicles participating in the "Prix Zrenjanina 2026 I and II" competition for the **National Championship, Open Championship of Serbia, SAKSS Championship** and **Open Championship of Vojvodina** will be divided into groups and classes:
- Group 1 - Production Cars**
 - **Class 1** – up to 1250 cc
 - **Class 2** – from 1251 to 1600 cc
 - **Class 3** – over 1600 cc
 - Group 2 - Sprint Cars**
 - **Class 4** – up to 1250 cc
 - **Class 5** – from 1251 to 1600 cc
 - **Class 6** – from 1601 to 2000 cc
 - **Class 7** – over 2000 cc
 - Group 3 – Sports Cars (Group N, A, R, H and E)**
 - **Class 8** - up to 1600 cc
 - **Class 9** – over 1600 cc
- 4.3.** For everything else, the provisions of the SAKSS Sporting Regulations and the Supplementary Regulations for Slalom for 2026 apply.

ARTICLE 5. COMPETITORS, DRIVERS, AND EQUIPMENT

- 5.1.** The right to participate in the Slalom is granted to all drivers who possess:
- A valid SAKSS driver's license for Slalom discipline for the current year
 - A valid medical certificate not older than six months from the date of issuance
 - Female drivers must sign a declaration confirming they are not pregnant at the time of the competition
 - For drivers under 18 years old, a notarized parental/guardian consent for participation in SAKSS-organized events
 - A life insurance policy for participation in the competition with a minimum amount of 200,000 RSD in case of death and 400,000 RSD in case of permanent disability

- A properly completed and stamped entry form from the driver's club for the competition,
- Proof of payment of the entry fee to the Organizer,
- For drivers from other national federations, a permit from the corresponding ASN for participation in the Slalom "ZRENJANIN 2026 I and II".

The competition takes place on a closed track, so it is not necessary for vehicles to have a valid road permit. For everything else, the regulations according to Annex "A" for Slalom apply.

- 5.2.** Double starts are allowed, meaning two drivers can use the same vehicle, but a single driver cannot start with two vehicles. In the case of a double start, each driver must pay the entry fee separately.
- 5.3.** During training and the race, including driving from the service park to the pre-start and returning from the end of the track to the service park:
- The use of a protective helmet is mandatory. The helmet must comply with Annex "A" for Slalom,
 - The use of safety belts is mandatory in accordance with Annex "A" for Slalom,
 - The use of clothing and footwear is mandatory in accordance with Annex "A" for Slalom.
- 5.4.** The driver's side window may be open no more than 5 cm during driving.
- 5.5.** It is mandatory to use a waterproof PVC protective sheet under the competition vehicle in the service park according to Article 17.2 of the Supplementary Regulations for Slalom for 2026.

ARTICLE 6. APPLICATIONS

- 6.1.** Applications and proof of payment of the entry fee for this competition should be sent to the email address: office@sakss.org.rs no later than 6:00 p.m. on May 25, 2026.
- 6.2.** The entry fee per day for participation in the National Championship of Serbia, the Open Championship of Serbia and Open Championship of Vojvodina is as follows:
- For Juniors:
 - Group 1** – 2,500 RSD
 - Group 2** – 3,000 RSD
 - Group 3** – 3,500 RSD
 - For others:
 - Group 1** – 5,000 RSD
 - Group 2** – 6,000 RSD
 - Group 3** – 7,000 RSD
- 6.3.** The entry fee for the FIA CEZ Championship for foreign ASN drivers is 12,000 RSD. For domestic drivers, the additional entry fee for the FIA CEZ Championship is 3,500 RSD.
- 6.4.** Team sponsor registration is done during verification with the team's sponsorship license. The fee is 6,000 RSD.
- 6.5.** Fees can be paid to:

- 6.6.** The organizer is obligated to accept only correctly completed applications that are received by the specified deadline.
- 6.7.** The driver must provide the original, properly completed, and stamped application form and proof of payment of the entry fee for participation in the competition by the time of verification.
- 6.8.** In case of a higher number of drivers, the organizer may accept additional applications up to a maximum number of 80. If there are more applications, the organizer reserves the right to decide who will participate.
- 6.9.** A driver may register a reserve vehicle during the Technical Inspection, provided that the vehicle is from the same class and has a technical vehicle book (TKV). The reserve vehicle may be one that someone else has already registered for the competition, but it cannot be a vehicle with a registered double start. The reserve vehicle that is accepted for the competition must be in the service park, if not in use.

ARTICLE 7. RESPONSIBILITY

- 7.1.** Each driver and competitor participates at their own risk. The organizer accepts no responsibility for injuries to third parties, competitors, and drivers, nor for damage to the property of drivers, competitors, or third parties. Each competitor and driver is responsible for all personal insurance.

7.2. The organizer will arrange insurance coverage for spectators and official personnel according to the rules of SAKSS.

ARTICLE 8. EVENT SCHEDULE

- 8.1.** The verification will take place in the zone between the service parking lot and the start, according to the given program, in:
- ✓ Saturday, May 30, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. for the competition "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I" for drivers who drive for the FIA CEZ Slalom Championship, National Championship of Serbia, Open Championship of Serbia and Open Championship of Vojvodina, and
 - ✓ Sunday, May 31, 2026, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. for the competition "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 II" for drivers who drive for the National Championship of Serbia, Open Championship of Serbia and Open Championship of Vojvodina.
- 8.2.** The Verification Committee will review all driver documents as specified in Article 12 of the Supplementary Regulations for Slalom for 2026. Drivers must personally report to the Verification Committee.
- 8.3.** The technical reception of the competition vehicles will take place in the zone between the service parking lot and the start, according to the given program, namely:
- ✓ Saturday, May 30, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. for the competition "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I" for drivers who drive for the FIA CEZ Slalom Championship, National Championship of Serbia, Open Championship of Serbia and Open Championship of Vojvodina, and
 - ✓ Sunday, May 31, 2026, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. for the competition "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 II" for drivers who drive for the National Championship of Serbia, Open Championship of Serbia and Open Championship of Vojvodina.
- 8.4.** The organizer's Technical Committee will inspect vehicles and driver equipment for compliance with FIA international regulations, vehicle homologation, the Supplementary Regulations for the competition, the Supplementary Regulations for Slalom, and Annex "A" for Slalom. Competition vehicles must arrive at the technical inspection with affixed start numbers and all required markings, fully prepared for the competition.
- 8.5.** After the technical reception, the competition vehicles are taken to the service parking lot, which is located in front of the pre-start zone.
- 8.6.** Trainings and races will be held on Saturday 30.05 and Sunday 31.05.2026. according to the competition program.
- 8.7.** Drivers in training and races start according to the start list at intervals of 30 or 60 seconds. The decision on the starting distance is made by the Competition Director.
- 8.8.** The start list for training is valid for both training runs and all races in one day of competition.
- 8.9.** The start is from a stationary position with the engine running. The start will be conducted using traffic lights. The finish will be flying. After the finish, the vehicle must be driven at reduced speed to the service park.
- 8.10.** After the final run of the race, the driver is obliged to take their competition vehicle to the closed parking lot, which is located at the end of the track (indicated on the sketch of the track) where they remain until it is dismissed by the Competition Director.
- 8.11.** Timing is done using devices that electronically, via photo cells, automatically record times with an accuracy of 1/1000 of a second. Photo cells at the start and finish are placed above the respective start and finish lines. The vehicle is positioned 1 meter in front of the start line. The timing starts when the front part of the competition vehicle crosses the light beam of the photo cell at the start, and stops when the same vehicle crosses the light beam of the photo cell at the finish.
- 8.12.** Only those drivers who have successfully completed at least two (2) runs are included in the race ranking. The ranking at the end of each competition is determined by the sum of the best achieved total time (with penalty) from two runs where the better driver is the one with the smallest total time. Participation in training is mandatory.

ARTICLE 9. BRIEFING – MEETING WITH DRIVERS

- 9.1.** The competition director will hold a meeting with the drivers - a briefing in:
- ✓ On Saturday, May 30, 2026, at 11:15 a.m. at the entrance to the pre-start zone, and
 - ✓ On Sunday, May 31, 2026, at 09:15 a.m. at the entrance to the pre-start zone.

9.2. Attendance will be recorded at the meeting, and it is mandatory for all drivers to be present.

ARTICLE 10. HONORARY AWARDS

10.1. The organizer will award honorary prizes – trophies – for:

- ✓ First, second, and third place in each CEZ Division - "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I".
- ✓ First, second, and third place in the overall standings - "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I and II",
- ✓ First, second, and third place in each class - "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I and II",
- ✓ First, second, and third place for ladies in the overall standings - "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I and II",
- ✓ First, second, and third place for juniors in the overall standings - "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I and II",
- ✓ First place for people with disabilities in the overall standings - "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I and II",
- ✓ Club teams - "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I and II",
- ✓ Sponsor teams - "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I and II".

10.2. If fewer than 3 drivers start in a class, the honorary prize will only be awarded for first place.

ARTICLE 11. AWARDS CEREMONY

11.1. Attendance at the awards ceremony is a personal and moral obligation of all participants in the competition.

11.2. The awards ceremony will be held on the track in the pre-start zone namely:

- ✓ For "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 I" competition on Saturday, May 30, 2026, around 7:00 p.m.,
- ✓ For "Prix Zrenjanin 2026 II" competition on Sunday, May 31, 2026, around 5:00 p.m.

ARTICLE 12. ADVERTISING

12.1. Mandatory advertising:

- ✓ On the front windshield, if applicable, a strip up to 15 cm wide with SAKSS advertising, provided by SAKSS, must be affixed across the top part of the windshield.
- ✓ The driver must ensure a space for the mandatory sticker of the competition organizer in the size of 450 cm² on the front left and right doors of the competition vehicle, below the glass. The organizer will provide the sticker to the driver during verification. If a driver refuses to display the organizer's advertisements, a fine of 20,000 RSD per rejected advertisement will be imposed.

ARTICLE 13. LEGAL LIABILITY

13.1. By participating in the competition, each competitor/driver waives all rights to objections regarding accidents that may occur to the competitor/driver or their assistants during practice and/or the race, or during the trip from the service park to the track and back. This waiver applies to Vojvodina Sports Association for Motoring, Sports Auto and Karting Association of Serbia and FIA, officials, and other competitors/drivers and their assistants.

ARTICLE 14. OBJECTIONS

14.1. Objections must be submitted immediately, no later than 30 minutes after the posting of the start lists or provisional results of practice or the race. Objections must be submitted in writing to the Competition Director or their designated representative, as informed to the drivers during the drivers' briefing.

14.2. Objections concerning vehicle completeness and dimensions may only be made after the technical inspection, i.e., no later than 15 minutes after the posting of the list of accepted drivers.

14.3. An objection not related to vehicle technical specifications must be accompanied by a deposit of 6,000 RSD, which will be refunded to the submitter in case of a negative finding.

14.4. An objection related to the verification of the technical correctness and compliance of the vehicle should be submitted to the Competition Director, and the objection must include a deposit determined by the Technical Commissioner, according to the pricing list for that objection.

14.5. If an objection is filed concerning the technical correctness of the vehicle, the Technical Secretary must conduct the inspection as directed by the Sports Commission and submit the findings with any imposed penalties, if technical non-compliance is found, to the SAKSS Secretary within 24 hours of the announcement of the provisional competition results.

14.6. Drivers have the right to appeal the penalty imposed by the Competition Director to the Sports Commission within the time frame allotted for objections to provisional results.

ARTICLE 15. ENVIRONMENT

- 15.1.** To protect the environment, the use of PVC impermeable mats (fuel and oil resistant) under the competition vehicle is mandatory in the service park, with dimensions extending 0.50 meters beyond the size of the vehicle on each side. If a driver does not have an appropriate mat, they will be excluded from the competition.
- 15.2.** Any dirtying of the service parking area is prohibited. The organizer reserves the right to fine any dirt on the track and service parking lot.
- 15.3.** It is strictly forbidden to light a fire. In case of violation of this rule, the Deputy Director for Safety has the right to order that the accompanying crew be removed from the Service Park.

ARTICLE 16. MISCELLANEOUS

- 16.1.** All teams, competitors, drivers, and club members must leave the NAVAK Center premises by 8:00 PM at the latest.
- 16.2.** The organizer reserves the right to amend and supplement the Supplementary Regulations, postpone or cancel the competition in case of force majeure. All amendments and supplements may be published via a Bulletin on the SAKSS website (www.sakss.org.rs) by May 25, 2026, or on the notice boards during the competition or to the formed Viber group.

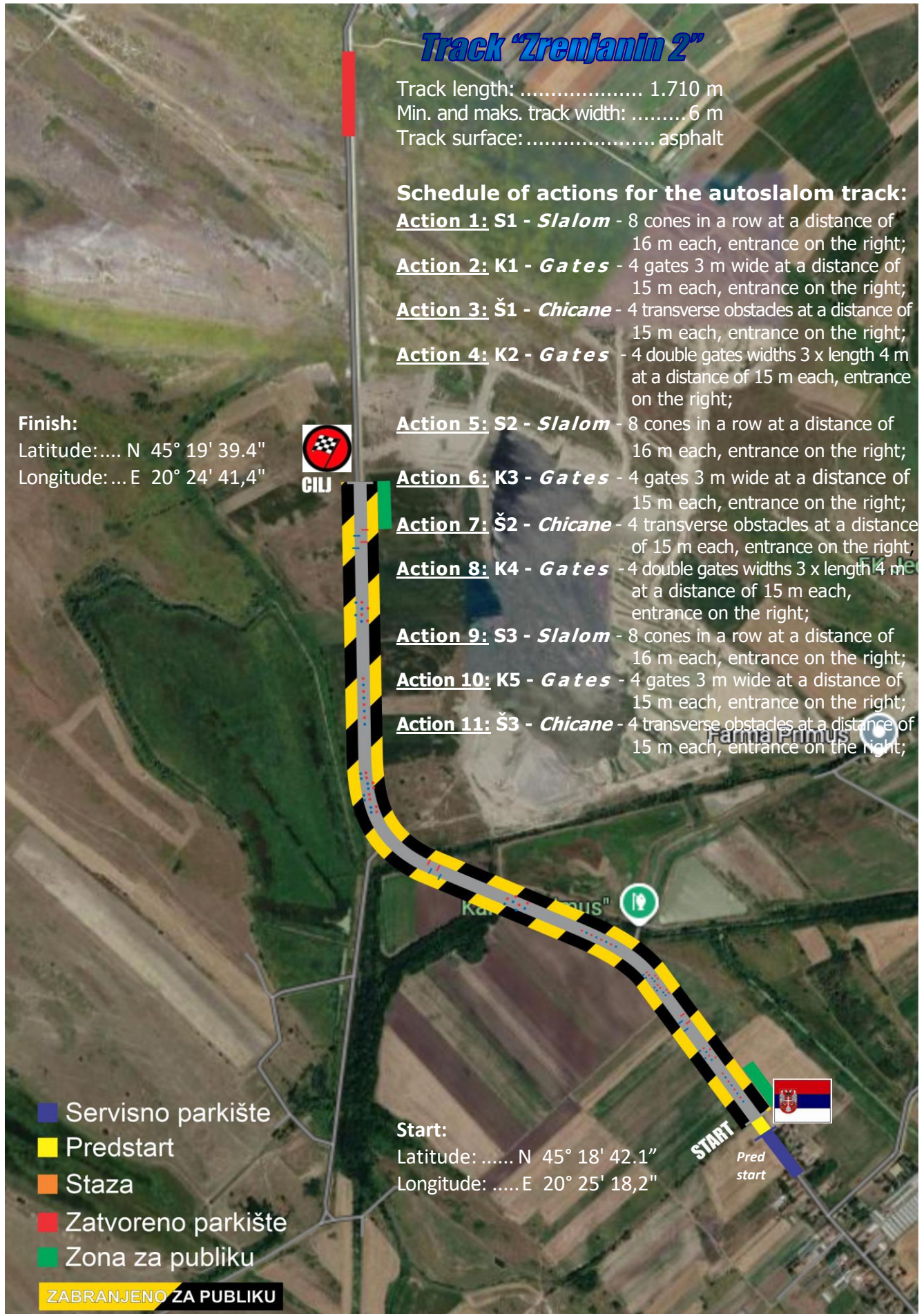

When the red flags are displayed, the drivers are obliged to stop the competition vehicle immediately and safely, stay in it with their seat belts and helmets on, and follow the instructions of the referees in the sport, which they received from the director. If this procedure is not respected, the drivers will be excluded from the competition.
